



The Skill Share Cabin is our new space to use vocational training to respond to the increasing cost-of-living, throwaway culture and its negative impact on our environment.

As part of our programme at our Teesside Hub, we want to build capacity among those with low-incomes to fix household items and maintain their home themselves.

Delivered in small, mixed-age groups, new basic DIY workshops will encourage peer-to-peer learning that leads to increased confidence and improved problem solving skills. Providing a stepping stone into further vocational learning for those who either:

- struggle to engage with mainstream education but are looking to move forward into employment; or
- feel increasingly isolated/ have a limited support network and would benefit from some face-to-face training in a community setting.
